WHAT IS THE STUDENT ASSISTANCE FUND?

The Student Assistance Fund is an emergency fund for students who need extra support for academic-related expenses as well as health and personal needs.

WHAT DOES THE FUND SUPPORT?

Academic Expenses

- Books, calculators, software and other academic materials.
- Classroom supplies such as paper, pens, notebooks, etc.
- Storage media such as SD cards and USB drives required by a course;
- Other implements required for courses.

Health and Personal Needs

- Small medical expenses, medication or health and hygiene supplies.
- Food or clothing.
- Transportation.

Immediate personal care items are available in the Student Services, Student Life and Student Success Center offices.

**There are annual limits on the amount each student can receive.*

WHO'S ELIGIBLE?

1. Must be a current student of Olivet College.
2. Must have a financial need as determined by the Student Services Office.
3. Must be a student in good standing.

HOW DO STUDENTS CONTRIBUTE?

In alignment with our vision for individual and social responsibility, students who participate in the fund demonstrate service to the College and greater Olivet community.
